

Social Media Update Of A Girl Complete Works Announced By Tourist Causes An Uproar CM In Time: Commisioner

Nainital: The Facebook status of girl, belonging to an influential family, who had come to visit Nainital as part of a larger group created quite an uproar. On the information of the family of the girl, a prominent leader of Uttarakhand contacted the SSP in the night. The Police was seen searching the girl in the hotels in the night itself.

According to information received from sources, on Saturday, a group of girls from Moradabad had come to visit Nainital. Meanwhile, a young woman took a selfie holding a glass of juice in the middle of the party at night. This was uploaded as a status on Facebook with a message "I am enjoying in Nainital with a drink."

When the family saw the picture they immediately got in touch with an influential leader of Uttarakhand, who in turn contacted the SSP. Acting upon instructions of the SSP, the police started searching the hotels in Nainital, but to no avail. In the meanwhile, the Police were continuously getting calls of the whereabouts of the girl. But the Police had no clue. However, after sometime, the Police got information about the group of girls visiting Nainital. The Police immediately reached the hotel only to find that the girl had uploaded the picture with a glass of juice. The family was informed and then the matter calmed down.

He instructed the District Magistrates to get the development works inspected by the concerned SDMs and provide photographs along with progress report at every 15 days. He said that the people should be in-

formed about the development works being done in their areas and coordinate with the MLAs of the concerned areas and ensure speed in the works. He said that signboards indicating the date of completion, date of completion and money spent, should be installed outside completed works. Wherever, land transfer has not been made, the officers should do all their power, to complete the transfer of land.

The Commissioner was informed that of the 105 announcements of the Chief Minister, 26 works have been completed in Almora district. Work on the balance is in progress. Similarly, out of 47 announcements by the Chief Minister in Bageshwar, 18 works have been completed while 29 works are in progress. Additional Commissioner Sanjay Khetwal, Director Medical Health Kumaon Dr. Aarti Dhodiyal, Additional Director of Education Basic Raghunath Lal Arya and several divisional officers were present in the VC.

Nestle To Set Up Rs 700 Crore Factory In Gujarat's Sanand

Mumbai: FMCG major Nestle India is setting up its ninth factory in the country at Sanand in Gujarat with an initial investment of Rs 700 crore over two years.

"This marks a significant step in enhancing our manufacturing footprint in line with our commitment to Make in India," said Chairman and Managing Director Suresh Narayanan.

"The state-of-the-art, environmentally sustainable factory for Maggi noodles will involve an initial investment of nearly Rs 700 crore over the next two



years and generate employment for about 400 people. We are keen to embrace diversity through at least 50 per cent women employees," he said.

Nestle India set up its first manufacturing facility at Moga in Punjab during 1961 followed by more facilities at Cholaodi in Tamil Nadu during 1967, Nanjangud in Karnataka during 1989, Samalkhula in Andhra during 1992, Ponda and Bicholim in Goa during 1995 and 1997, and Pantnagar in Uttarakhand during 2006. In 2012, the company set up its eighth manufacturing facility at Tahlival in Himachal Pradesh. Nestle India reported a net profit of Rs 438 crore during April to June, up 10.8 per cent from Rs 395 crore in the corresponding quarter of last fiscal. Revenue from operations grew 11.2 per cent to Rs 3,000.85 crore. The domestic sales increased by 13.1 per cent largely driven by volume and mix besides positively influenced by sales to CSD and sale of surplus fat. But export sales dropped by 13.9 per cent due to lower coffee exports to Turkey, it said in a statement. The Swiss multinational food and drink processing conglomerate corporation is based in India for 107 years.

Two More INLD MLAs, 1 Ind Join BJP In Haryana

Chandigarh: The Indian National Lok Dal (INLD) suffered another jolt when two more of its legislators left the party and joined the ruling BJP in the presence of Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar and party state president Subhash Barala here on Monday.

Independent MLA from Safidon Jasbir Deswal also joined the saffron party ahead of Haryana Assembly elections.

Rania legislator Ram Chander Kamboj and Firozpur Jhirka MLA Naseem Ahmed joined the BJP. Kamboj had recently resigned from the INLD while Deswal has been supporting the ruling party.

Mr Barala claimed that two INLD MLAs and an independent legislator have joined the ruling party "unconditionally".

Recently, Rania legislator Ravinder Baliola had ditched the INLD and joined the BJP along with former minister Jagdish Yadav. Several INLD MLAs had left the party and joined the ruling BJP after a feud in the Chautala family. UNI

Rajesh Kumar Srivastava Takes Charge As ONGC Director (Exploration)

Dehradun / New Delhi: Mr. Rajesh Kumar Srivastava took charge as the new Director (Exploration) of energy major Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) Limited on 2 August 2019.

He takes over the reins of exploration of India's flagship explorer upon superannuation of Mr A K Dwivedi on 31 July. A post-graduate from Lucknow University, with Masters Degree in Engineering Geology from Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur, Mr Srivastava joined ONGC as Geologist in 1984 at Krishna Godavari Basin, Rajahmundry.

Speaking after assuming office, Mr Srivastava shared his views in regard to future potential for improvement in Exploration and Development to realize the goals set by ONGC. He emphasized the need to focus on play-based exploration as the way forward to further energy search by bringing in new

areas under the ambit of exploration. He shared that priorities for exploration fraternity would be to open up the new plays, consolidate the successes for early monetization, acquisition of new acreages including NSP covered areas, be-



panies working for field growth opportunities.

"Taking a leaf from ONGC 2.0 concept recently advocated by his predecessor Mr A K Dwivedi, Mr Srivastava called for a unified effort from all quarters to march towards a better tomorrow and a sustainable growth of the organization. He earnestly hopes from all the stakeholders for convergence in realizing the goal of the com-

pany. With over 35 years of experience, Mr Srivastava is an expert in up-stream hydrocarbon exploration from well site

operations (on-land & offshore), development geology, seismic data interpretation to monitoring and planning of exploration.

Mr Srivastava began his career as exploration Geologist from geologically complex KG-PG Basin. At IRS, Ahmedabad he was considered as one of the best hands in the trade of Reservoir modelling for preparation of field development plans, simulation studies for production forecast and techno-economic evaluation of prospects. He is credited to have introduced art/science of geo-cellular modelling in ONGC, Neelam being the first full field fine scale geo cellular model for dynamic modelling for redevelopment.

During his tenure at E&D Directorate, he was closely associated with the exploration and development activities of Assam & Assam-Arakan Basin, MBA Basin and Krishna-Godavari & Cauvery basins. He was one of the important members during formulation of 'Hydrocarbon vision-2050 for North East India' prepared by MoPNG. He has also evaluated several exploration & development blocks of Egypt & Sudan. With his commendable work, Mr Srivastava was honored with the National Mineral Award in 2009.

Golden Cards Of 12.31 Lakh Beneficiaries Made In Haryana Under Ayushman Bharat Yojana: Uj

Chandigarh: Haryana Health Minister Anil Vij said that as many as golden cards of 12.31 lakh beneficiaries have been made in the state, under Ayushman Bharat Yojana and 37,885 patients have availed benefit of this scheme so far.

Responding to a question raised during the Vidhan Sabha Session here Monday, Mr Vij said that under this scheme, the central government is providing free medical facilities up to Rs five lakhs to any eligible family. For this, the people availing benefit of the scheme need not make any payment or premium, but this facility is absolutely free for eligible people.

He said that Haryana has bagged the first position in the country in terms of successful implementation of this scheme and the central government has also encouraged other states to follow Haryana. This scheme has been implemented on the basis of the survey of the year 2011 and for this, as soon as a new survey would be conducted by the central government, Haryana would implement it.

Amarinder Reviews Law And Order In Punjab After Kashmir Developments



Chandigarh: Amid apprehension of an adverse reaction from Pakistan to the developments in Kashmir, Punjab Chief Minister Capt Amarinder Singh on Monday prohibited any kind of celebration or protest that could vitiate the atmosphere in the state.

With tension escalating at the border, the Chief Minister directed the Punjab Police to be prepared to thwart any attempts by Pakistan to create disturbance in the state.

Capt Amarinder was reviewing the law and order situation in the state in the wake of the revocation of Article 370 in Kashmir. Top police and civil brass attended the review meeting, which took note of the volatile situation post the Central Government's announcement on Kashmir.

"Pakistan may not take this lightly and could resort to some act against India," the Chief Minister warned, asking the state police to be ready for any eventuality. Capt Amarinder has ordered increased security for the 8000-odd Kashmiri students in Punjab, and directed SPs and DCs to meet them and talk to them personally.

The Chief Minister, who is personally monitoring the situation, has ordered scaling up of security in Punjab's districts that border Kashmir. He reiterated his earlier directions to the police and the district administration to ensure smooth and safe movement of those leaving Kashmir via Punjab. The border areas of the state have been heightened alert for the past two days, since tourists and Amarnath Yatriks were asked to leave the Valley, citing security concerns.

Meanwhile, he has appealed to all, within and outside Kashmir, to remain calm and not do anything to disturb the peace and harmony of the nation in these difficult circumstances.

The meeting was attended, among others by Chief Minister's Media Advisor Raveen Thakral, CPSCM, Suresh Kumar, Chief Secretary Karam Avtar Singh, Punjab DGP Dinkar Gupta, Home Secretary Satish Chandra, DGP (Intelligence) V K Bhatwara and PSCM Tejveer Singh. UNI
