

Patanjali Launches Ayurvedic COVID-19 Medicine, Claims 100% Recovery Within 3-7 Days

Haridwar: Patanjali on Tuesday launched 'Coronil and Swasari', what it claims is the Ayurvedic cure for treating COVID-19, which they said has been shown 100 per cent favourable results during clinical trials on affected patients, at Patanjali Yogpeeth here. The efficacy of Patanjali's medicine on Covid cure has not been corroborated by any independent medical body as yet. The World Health Organization (WHO) had recently said that while several drug trials are ongoing, there is currently no proof that any drug can cure or prevent COVID-19. The organisation had added that it was coordinating efforts to develop and evaluate medicines to treat COVID-19.

"The whole country and the world was waiting for medicine or vaccine for corona. We are proud to announce that the first Ayurvedic, clinically controlled trial based evidence and research-based medicine has been prepared by the combined efforts of Patanjali Research Centre and NIMS, Yoga Guru Ramdev said at the press conference here adding that it has shown "100 per cent recovery rate within 3-7 days." "We are launching COVID medicines Coronil and Swasari today. We conducted two trials of these, first clinical controlled study, which took place in Delhi, Ahmedabad, among many other cities. Under this 280 patients were included and 100 per cent of those recovered. We were able to control Corona and its complications in this. After this all-important clinical controlled trial was conducted," he added.

He thanked the Director, National Institute of Medical Sciences, NIMS University, Jaipur, Dr Balbir Singh Tomar and all other doctors and scientists for their help in creating the medicine. "With the help of NIMS, Jaipur we conducted the clinical control study on 95 patients. The biggest thing which came out of this is that within three days 69 per cent patients recovered and became negative from positive (cases) and within seven days 100 per cent of them became negative," he added.

He also said that necessary approvals for conducting the trials of medicine on patients had been taken from competent authorities. Acharya Balkrishna, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Patanjali, was also present at the occasion of the launch along with other officials and representatives who had taken part in the preparation of the medicine.

With an increase of 14,933 new cases and 312 deaths in the last 24 hours, India's COVID-19 count reached 4,40,215 on Tuesday. According to the latest update by the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), 14,011 deaths have been recorded due to the infection so far in the country. —ANI

103 More COVID-19 Cases In Uttarakhand

Dehradun: With an increase of 103 COVID-19 cases, Uttarakhand's tally of coronavirus cases reached 2,505 on Tuesday.

According to the Health Bulletin issued by the Directorate of Medical Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand, the tally includes 1,541 cured and recovered patients while 920 active cases are there in the state. 29 deaths have been reported due to the disease in the state so far.

The doubling rate for Uttarakhand in the past seven days stood at 22.37 days while the percentage recovery for patients in the state is at 61.52 per cent, according to the Health Bulletin. —ANI



Bridge Collapses Near India-China Border In Uttarakhand



Dehradun: A bailey bridge in this district of Uttarakhand, nearly 50 km from the Sino-India border, collapsed when a truck carrying a JCB machine was crossing it, an official said on Tuesday.

The truck driver and the JCB machine operator were injured as the 40-feet-long bridge, built in 2009, crashed on Monday under the combined weight of the truck and the JCB machine, SDM of Munswari A K Shukla said.

The weight-bearing capacity of the bridge was 18 tonnes while the combined weight of the JCB machine and the truck was 26 tonnes, he said.

The SDM said the truck driver and the JCB machine operator have been admitted to a hospital in Munswari.

Around 15 border villages of Johar Valley have been cut off. Legal action will be taken against the truck driver, the official said. Construction of another bridge will take at least 15 days, the SDM said. PTI

Bus Services To Start From June 25 In Uttarakhand



Dehradun (The Hawk): The Uttarakhand Transport department would start plying of buses from 25 June in Uttarakhand. This decision was taken in the meeting of the Uttarakhand Transport Corporation Board. The Board President Additional Chief Secretary Om Prakash said that after the meeting, it was decided to start the plying of the buses. 50 buses would be run in the first phase. The second phase would be launched after the success of the first phase. The meeting also decided to provide the benefit of the Atal Ayushman scheme to the employees of the Uttarakhand Roadways Corporation. The meeting also approved loan for 300 buses. The meeting decided that if the acquisition is not finalized then the land of the Dehradun ISBT would be given to the Dehradun Municipal Corporation

U'khand CM Lays Wreath On Soldier's Body



Dehradun: Uttarakhand Chief Minister Trivendra Singh Rawat on Tuesday laid a flower wreath on the mortal remains of an 8th Garhwal Rifles soldier who died of cardiac arrest while on duty in Poonch sector of Jammu and Kashmir.

Laying the wreath on the body of Surendra Singh Negi, Rawat prayed for peace to his soul and for strength to his family members to bear the loss.

The chief minister said the state government will extend all help to the jawan's family. Negi, 38, had returned from patrolling on Sunday when he complained of pain in the chest. He was rushed to a hospital where he died during

Delhi Court Dismisses Interim Bail Plea Of Rohit Tiwari's Wife

New Delhi: A Delhi court Tuesday dismissed an interim bail application of Apoorva Shukla, arrested in connection with the alleged murder of her husband Rohit Tiwari, the son of former Uttarakhand chief minister N D Tiwari.

Shukla had sought interim bail for two months on the ground that she suffered spinal column injury in Tihar jail where she is currently lodged. Additional Sessions Judge Sandeep Yadav directed the Tihar Jail Superintendent to ensure her medical treatment at Safdarjung Hospital here, said her lawyer. In her interim bail application, filed through advocate Mehmoond Pracha, she said that she suffered slip disc

injury by slipping in jail. The court had earlier directed the jail authorities to provide treatment to Shukla at a good hospital other than the jail dispensary and Deen Dayal Upadhyay (DDU) Hospital for her psychological problems which include depression and sleep disturbance. Rohit's mother Ujjwala Tiwari had alleged before the court that Shukla had married Rohit as he was the son of the late veteran politician and she believed she would get a ticket to contest elections at Indore after marrying him. Ujjwala, who was represented by advocate Tariq Nasir, had alleged that relations turned tense between Rohit and his wife immediately after their marriage and she fought with him on trivial issues.

Shukla, a lawyer, was arrested on April 26 last year on charges of Tiwari's murder. Rohit was smothered to death on the intervening night of April 15 and 16, the autopsy report had said. PTI
