

# Rehabilitation Of Kalagarh Residents: NGT Raps U'khand Govt, Slaps Fine Of Rs 3 Lakh

New Delhi: The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has rapped the Uttarakhand government for not demolishing illegal structures inside Kalagarh, the most sensitive core area of the Jim Corbett Tiger Reserve, saying it was trying to "frustrate" its directions.

A bench headed by acting Chairperson Justice Jawad Rahim slapped a penalty of Rs 3 lakh on the state government for not filing an affidavit on demolition and asked it to file the document within a week.

The green panel said that it had ordered demolition of the illegal structures inside Kalagarh. However, the state government was trying to delay compliance on the pretext that land for rehabilitation was not available.

"From the narration of the facts as stated, the intention of State appears not honest. The order has not been complied on one pretext or the other and now the ground created is about want of land for rehabilitation before the demolition could take place. In the circumstances, we are justified in concluding that unless a serious view is taken, the State will again frustrate the directions of the Tribunal," the bench said.

The state government on September 21 last year had assured the tribunal that inhabitants would be removed and structures would be demolished as expeditiously as possible from the Jim Corbett National Park and in any case not more than one year. It had also said that the Deputy Commissioner of the area would file status-cum compliance report, every three



months before the tribunal, to show progress in compliance of directions. However, no status report has been filed de-

Corbett Tiger Reserve in Kalagarh. Status of these structures and the area which is to be marked as eco-sensitive zone beyond the limits of the park.

In its December 2013 judgement, the Supreme Court had upheld the 2004 report of its Central Empowered Committee (CEC) to return the encroached New Kalagarh irrigation colony to the Corbett Tiger Reserve and set a six-month deadline for the state government to ensure compliance.

In August 1966, the Forest Department of undivided Uttar Pradesh had handed over around 9,000 hectares of Corbett National Park land to the state Irrigation Department for the Ramganga hydel project.

The houses were built for people at the site during the construction of the Ram Ganga Dam also known as the Kalagarh Dam, which was completed in 1974.

The Supreme Court had handed this case over to the National Green Tribunal last year. PTI

## Water Crisis Looming Large Over Himachal, Warn Environmentalists

Shimla: As Shimla faces one of its worst water crises, sending locals on the warpath and making tourists cutting short their stay, environmentalists warn water scarcity not only looms large over the city but the entire Himalayan state.

Himdhara, a state-based environment research and action collective, on Wednesday said a massive crisis is unfolding in the Himalayan rivers due to the upcoming hydropower projects.

The water crisis unfolding in the state's various regions, especially Shimla, needs an urgent action plan, Himdhara's Manish Aher told IANS.

Citing the organisation's "Dried and Dusty: A State of the Rivers Report for Himachal Pradesh", she said upcoming hydropower projects, urbanisation, spike in tourism, industrialisation, mining and, of course, climatic change are affecting the Satluj, Ravi, Beas, Chenab and Yamuna river basins.

Except the Satluj, which has its source in Tibet, the other rivers originate in the state.

The 2017 report warns local ecology and livelihoods are threatened by 41 big hydro and dam projects and 91 small and micro projects.

As per a 2015 report of the Indian Council of Forestry Research and

Education of 2015, a total of 11,065,346 hectares in the state has been diverted for different development activities since 1980, including 62 per cent of the forest land for hydropower projects and transmission lines.

In the Satluj basin, there will 185 km of tunnels once all planned hydro projects are built, it says. If all planned projects in Himachal Pradesh and across the Himalayas are constructed, there will be hundreds of kilometres of tunnels underneath the mountains, through which most of the Ravi, Satluj, Beas and Chenab waters will flow, and there will hardly be any long stretches of these rivers that will be free-flowing, said Aher.

In many cases, the distance between two hydro projects is less than a kilometre with some like Rampur receiving water directly from the tail of upstream projects, impacting fish migration.

## Price Mockery: Amarinder Calls I Paisa Cut In Fuel Prices Craze Joke On People

Chandigarh: Punjab Chief Minister Capt Amarinder Singh has described as a cruel joke on the people the one paisa cut each in the per litre price of petrol and diesel by the central government.

"Clerical error? Nobody can believe that. It is just another joke the Narendra Modi government has perpetrated on the people of the country," said the Chief Minister, reacting to reports that contrary to earlier claims of 60 paise and 56 paise cut each, the price of petrol and diesel had actually been slashed by a measly one paisa each. Ridiculing the one paisa cut, Capt Amarinder said it was "laughable". No wonder people were scorning the move on the social media and otherwise, he added.

It was said that the central government, with no clear public welfare policies in place, was unable to check the escalating petroleum prices in the country even though prices of petroleum products in the international market had been continuously coming down, the Chief Minister said.

Capt Amarinder said the Punjab Pradesh Congress Committee (PPCC) will join the nation-wide protest of the Congress party against the uncontrolled fuel price hike in full force on Thursday. All PPCC units will be out on the streets to take on the central government over the issue, he added. UNI
