# Uttarakhand: 91 Pilgrims Die Since Char Dham Yatra Started This Year

**Dehradun:** A total of 91 pilgrims have lost their lives during the course of the Char Dham Yatra in Uttarakhand since the pilgrimage began on May 3 this year, informed the officials on Friday.

Uttarakhand Director-General (DG) Health Shrija Bhatt cited heart attack as the primary reason behind the reported deaths on Friday.

"Most of the pilgrims died due to heart attacks. Also, health ser-



vices in Char Dham have been strengthened as compared to earlier," Bhatt told ANI. An addition of 169 doctors has been deployed. Char Dham yatra began with the opening of Gangotri and Yamunotri portals for devotees on May 3, on the occasion of Akshay Tritiya in the presence of Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami. While Kedarnath reopened on May 6, the doors of Badrinath opened on May 8. —ANI

# U'khand To Implement Uniform Civil Code

**Champawat:** The Uttarakhand government on Friday announced its decision to implement the Uniform Civil Code in the state.

"We have taken a decision to implement the Uniform Civil Code in the state. Uttarakhand will be the second state after Goa to implement this," Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said.

"We will bring UCC for the people irrespective of them being from any religion and section of the society," Dhami assured during his address in Champawat.

Earlier on May 2, Himachal Pradesh CM Jairam Thakur also announced that the UCC



will be brought into the state soon.

However, a debate over the UCC has sparked

in several states of the country, recently Assam CM Himanta Biswa Sarma also backed it by

saying that the UCC should be implemented in the greater interest of Muslim women otherwise polygamy would continue.

"Meanwhile, the All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB) termed it an unconstitutional and anti-minorities move", and called the rhetoric for bringing the law an attempt by Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, and Central governments to divert the attention from the concerns of inflation, economy, and rising unemployment.

Notably, in Bharatiya Janata Party's 2019 Lok Sabha election manifesto, BJP promised the implementation of UCC if it comes to power. —ANI
