



One Killed In Landslide In Uttarakhand

Dehradun: One person was killed in a landslide triggered by incessant rains in Uttarakhand, even as the roads to Kedarnath and Badrinath remained blocked at several places affecting the Charidham Yatra, officials said today.

Balwant Singh (31) died after being hit by rocks and debris following a landslide in Munsyari area of Pithoragarh district last evening, State Emergency Operations Centre said here.

Many roads in the state including Rishikesh-Badrinath, Rishikesh-Kedarnath and Rishikesh-Gangotri highways remained blocked at several places due to debris following the landslide, officials said. The road to Kedarnath is blocked at Munkatiya and Dolia Devi near Guptkashi while the highway to Badrinath is blocked by at Lambog. The road to Gangotri is also blocked at Ganganani and Army gate Harshil, they said.

Incessant rains have caused the water levels of most rivers to rise. However, the Ganga river is flowing around one metre below the danger mark at both Haridwar and Rishikesh.

Rain Continues In Himachal Pradesh

Shimla: The hills of Himachal Pradesh continued to experience moderate to heavy rain on Friday with Nadam town recording the highest rainfall in the state at 217 mm, officials said.

More rain is in store till Sunday, the Met office said. "Monsoon was active in the state during the past 24 hours. Precipitation occurred at most places with very heavy rainfall in Kangra and Hamirpur district," said an official of the Met Office.

He said similar weather conditions are likely to continue in the state till August 14 and thereafter the intensity of rainfall would decline for the next three days. Nagrota Stryani and Guler towns in Kangra district got 213 mm and 156 mm rainfall respectively.

State capital Shimla got 19.8 mm rain, while picturesque tourist resort Manali experienced 22.6 mm rainfall. Meanwhile, more than 40 villages were badly affected with the washing away of the 44-year-old Kandori bridge on the Indora-Damtal road in the floodwaters on Thursday.

However, no was injured in the incident, the police said. Traffic on the Indora-Damtal road has been diverted through Kalhagra and Malot link roads, Narpur sub-divisional magistrate Rakesh Prajapati said.

There were reports of link road closure in the interiors of Shimla, Sirmour, Mandi, Kangra and Kullu districts, hampering movement of traffic.

In Shimla town, more than 20 trees were uprooted in the incessant rainfall over the past few days, damaging public and private property. With continuous rainfall for the past few days, the rain deficit in the state from June 1 to August 12 has been reduced to 13 per cent, said the meteorological office. A government spokesperson said the Salluj, Beas and Yamuna rivers and their tributaries are in spate in Kinnaur, Shimla, Kullu, Mandi, Bilaspur and Sirmour districts.

NGT Orders De-Sealing Of Hotel In Haridwar

New Delhi: The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has ordered de-sealing of a Haridwar-based hotel, which was shut for allegedly polluting river Ganga, after Uttarakhand Pollution Control Board informed that it was complying with the pollution norms.

A bench headed by NGT Chairperson Justice Swatanter Kumar, however, restrained the hotel from discharging any effluent or sewage untreated or otherwise into the sewer connection.

During the hearing, the counsel appearing for the board told the tribunal that Park Prime Hotel has got its own sewage treatment plant (STP) and is located at a reasonable distance from river Ganga.

"In view of the statement made, we allow this application and direct the seal of the hotel be re-

moved. The hotel be permitted to carry on its business subject to the conditions," the bench said.

Flood Situation Grim In Rajasthan

Jaipur: South-eastern Rajasthan continued to be hit by floods as heavy rain lashed Bhiwara, Chittorgarh and surrounding districts, increasing the water levels in many river.

The army and NDRF teams rescued 216 people after flood waters engulfed an entire village in Sapotana area of Karauli district, while eight members of a family were airlifted from Alwar on Thursday.

The water levels at Bedach, a tributary of Banas and Gambhiri rivers, caused concern in Chittorgarh district. Control room in-charge Prakash Chand said many have been moved to safer places in Bhiwara.

ward and was centered at about 280 km from Balasore in Odisha.

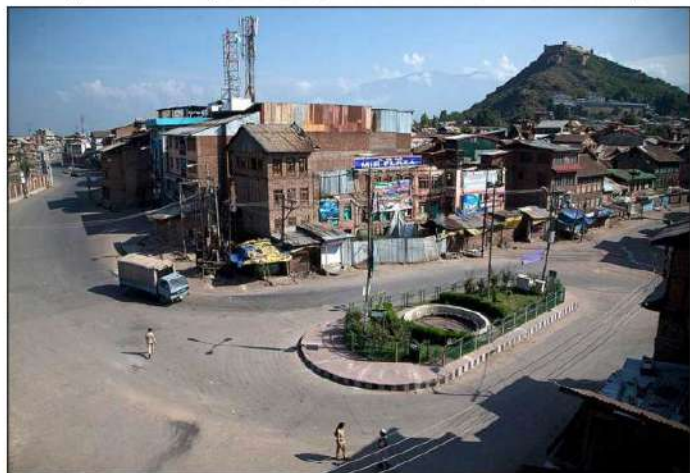

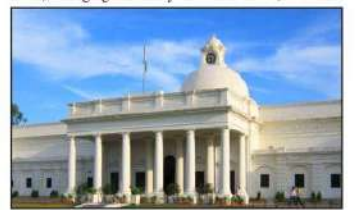

IIT-Roorkee Takes Back 18 Expelled Students

Roorkee: IIT-Roorkee has taken back all the 18 students, belonging to socially backward castes, who were



recently expelled for under-performance in their first B Tech examination, days after the Union HRD Ministry asked the institute to reconsider its decision.

The decision was taken by IIT-Roorkee's Senate after a marathon six-hour meeting last night, Dean (Academics) Pramod Agarwal said.

"All the 18 students who were expelled earlier have been taken back. Their humble family background is what prompted us to give them another chance to prove their merit," he said.

Eleven students were expelled by the institute last month for scoring less than the mandatory five CGPA. But, one of them was taken back later on humanitarian grounds as he was suffering from a physical disability. Eight more students were expelled earlier this month.

Some of the expelled students had approached the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development seeking its intervention in the matter following which the latter requested the institute to reconsider its decision. Last year too IIT-Roorkee had sent home 72 students on the same ground, out of which 64 were taken back later.

Parrikar To Inaugurate Bharat Parv Festival At India Gate

New Delhi: As part of Independent Day celebrations, Defence Minister Manohar Parrikar will inaugurate 'Bharat Parv' festival at India Gate tomorrow.

The inauguration ceremony of the festival, which will conclude on August 18, will also be attended by Union Ministers M Venkaiah Naidu and Mahesh Sharma.

"Bharat Parv is being organized by Government of India as part of Independence Day celebrations-2016. The prime objective of organizing the event is to generate a patriotic mood, promote the rich cultural diversity of the country and to ensure wider participation of the general public," Tourism Ministry Secretary Vinod Zutshi told a press conference here.

He said the Ministry of Tourism has been designated as the nodal ministry for the event, highlights of which would include performances by the Armed Forces Bands (static and moving), a multi-cuisine food court,

crafts mela, cultural performances from different regions of the country.



Ministry of Information and Broadcasting is also setting up 'Azadi 70 Saal- Yaad Karo Kurbaan' - a photo exhibition on the occasion of 70th Independence Day celebrations. The 'Food Court' at the event will have 50 stalls set up by various states/UTs, National Association of Street Vendors of India (NASVI) showcasing street food from different regions as well as by the Institutes of Hotel Management and ITDC.

Another crafts mela with 50 stalls will showcase the diverse handicrafts of the country, arranged by the state governments and Ministry of

Textiles.

There will be 17 theme state pavilions where each state would showcase their achievements and initiatives, tourism products and destinations, Zutshi said.

He said that the participating states and Union Territories in the event include - Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Daman and Diu, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, and Kerala.

He said other states participating at the event are Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.
