Kathgodam, marking the grand conclusion of the prestigious sporting event.

With the National Games scheduled to conclude on February 14, the state government is ensuring that all arrangements are in place for a smooth and successful ceremony. The presence of Amit

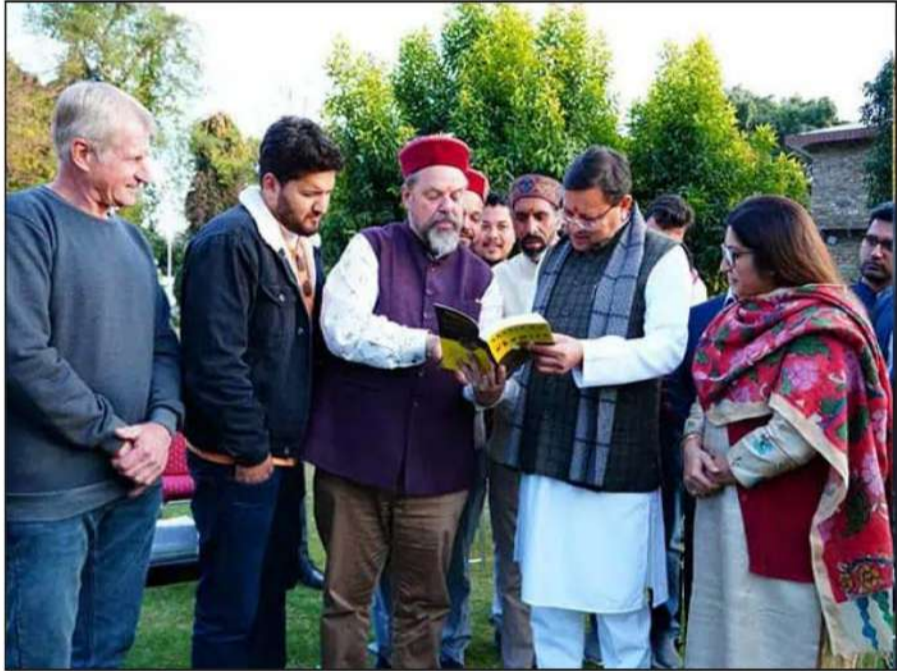
Shah is expected to add significance to the event, which has witnessed top athletes from across the country competing in various disciplines.

CM Dhama's active involvement highlights the importance of the National Games for Uttarakhand, not only as

a sporting spectacle but also as a platform to showcase the state's ability to host major national events.

On February 12, CM Dhama attended the Wrestling competition organised in this event. The event in Haridwar saw CM Dhama show his support for the athletes competing in various wrestling categories. He also attended the 'Maui Samvad'- National Sports Vision Conclave 2025 organised under the 38th National Games, 2025. Later, the CM tried his hands at hockey alongside various participants. —ANI

Australian Tunnel Expert Professor Arnold Dix Meets CM Dhama



Dehradun: Australian tunnel expert Professor Arnold Dix met with Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama on Wednesday, presenting him with a book about the Silkyara rescue operation, titled "The Promise."

In addition, CM Dhama sanctioned several financial allocations for infrastructure and development projects across Uttarakhand, including

road construction, religious site development, and university staff benefits, according to an official statement.

A sum of Rs 65.10 lakh has been approved for the construction of a link road from Dolma to Birthi Talari for the Pithoragarh Assembly Constituency. Additionally, Rs 39.06 lakh has been sanctioned for the development of the Shiv Mandir Mela Sthal in

Gram Sabha Nirtoli under the Dharcula Assembly Constituency.

For the financial year 2024-25, the Chief Minister has also approved Rs 35.784 lakh for constructing a CC road from Nirtoli Public Works Department Guest House to Burani in Pithoragarh. Another Rs 66.82 lakh has been sanctioned for unspecified development works, with Rs 40.092 lakh set aside un-

der this allocation.

In a major boost to university staff welfare, Dhama approved Rs 6.40 crore for the interest accrued on General Provident Fund (GPF) deposits of teachers and non-teaching staff at Kumaon University. Further, under the scheme for constructing office buildings for urban local bodies lacking permanent facilities, the government has sanctioned Rs 195.64 lakh for Nagar Panchayat Shaktigarh and Lalpur in Udham Singh Nagar district, along with an additional allocation of Rs 117.38 lakh. —ANI

PM Modi To Visit Harshil-Mukhwa In Uttarkashi On Feb 27, Preparations Underway

Dehradun: Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to visit the Harshil-Mukhwa area of Uttarkashi district on February 27 as part of his winter tour.

In anticipation of the visit, the state government and administration have ramped up preparations.

Uttarakhand Chief Secretary Radha Raturi convened a meeting with officials to review the arrangements for the visit, emphasising the timely and flawless execution of tasks.

She directed all concerned departments to ensure necessary preparations were completed and all arrangements were foolproof within the given timeframe.

Chief Secretary Raturi said that this visit of the Prime Minister will provide an invaluable opportunity to promote winter tourism in Uttarakhand. Hence, special attention should be paid to highlighting the possibilities and capabilities of winter tourism in the state in the programs to be organized during this period.

The Chief Secretary instructed that all preparations should be ensured on time, keeping in mind the prescribed protocol and security arrangements during the proposed programs of the Prime Minister in Harshil-Mukhwa.

The Chief Secretary said that she herself would go to Harshil-Mukhwa along with the officials and inspect the preparations on the spot and check all the arrangements.

The Chief Secretary directed that appropriate arrangements should be made for the proposed program of the public meeting in Harshil, including darshan-puja at Mukhwa temple, by the Prime Minister, and ef-

fective arrangements should also be made for parking and transport system. Along with instructing the Secretary of Tourism to organize an exhibition of winter tourist places of Uttarakhand in Harshil, she also said that an exhibition based on the local products of the state should also be organized on this occasion.

In the meeting, Secretary Vinod Kumar Suman presented the proposed programs and expected arrangements and said that all the concerned departments should immediately complete all the necessary preparations. On this occasion, District Magistrate Uttarkashi Dr Meherban Singh Bisht said that all the necessary arrangements are being ensured in the district regarding the proposed program.

Levelling work has been done for the Prime Minister's program on the premises of the Horticulture Department in Harshil. Along with the beautification of the temple and village buildings in Mukhwa, a convenient and safe path has been constructed for the temple.

The roads of the Harshil-Mukhwa area are being repaired. The construction of the road up to Bagori helipad in Harshil is in its final stage and other nearby helipads are also being made ready.

Along with the construction of parking in Harshil and Mukhwa, parking arrangements are also being made on the Gangotri highway. To solve the problem of drinking water lines getting damaged due to water freezing in winter, arrangements for drinking water supply have been made by laying HDPE pipes of about five km length in this area.

Along with repairing

the electricity lines and changing the poles in this area, solar high mast lights and street lights have been installed. Three new smart toilets are being built in this area. Presenting the details of all other arrangements related to the program, the District Magistrate said that all the preparations are in the final stage. —ANI

Fake Army Recruitment Racket Busted In Pune, One Arrested

Pune / Dehradun: Pune city police and Southern Command Military Intelligence busted a fake Army Recruitment racket in Pune city in a joint operation and arrested one individual, officials said on Wednesday.

The accused has been identified as Mohit Ram Singh Dhama a resident of Uttarakhand. He was apprehended from Pune Railway Station at approximately 8:30 PM on Tuesday, police said.

The arrest followed a complaint by 23-year-old Dhule resident of Ravindra Janardan Bilade, who claimed that Dhama deceived him and his friend of Rs 4.80 lakh.

The incident took place on March 31, 2024, when Bilade and his friend were in Pune for a government job recruitment exam.

According to Bilade's complaint, Dhama posed as a Southern Command Hospital employee and promised to secure their selection in the army despite their age exceeding the limit. Over the next few days, Dhama collected their documents and money, with Bilade sending Rs 2.80 lakh and his friend sending Rs 2 lakh.

The scam extended beyond these individuals, targeting financially disadvantaged candidates from Uttarakhand, Punjab, and Maharashtra. Dhama reportedly charged each candidate Rs 2 lakh for the fake recruitment. Police anticipates that at least 10-15 more aspirant have been defrauded by the accused, police have appealed that victims come forward and file their complaints proactively.

The Southern Intelligence Command in Pune provided military-specific information about Dhama's involvement in the fake recruitment racket to the Bund Garden Police on February 11, 2024. After verification, the joint team apprehended Dhama on Tuesday.

The Bund Garden Police have filed charges against Dhama under Sections 319(2) and 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), addressing cheating by personation and cheating with dishonest inducement to investigate the case further. —ANI

patience for the bereaved family. The Chief Minister has directed the Director General of Information, Banshidhar Tiwari, to provide all possible help and financial assistance to Manjul Manjila's family members as per the prescribed provisions.

During this, Mayor Dehradun Saurabh Thapliyal and Banshidhar Tiwari were also present.

Reportedly, Manjila passed away due to a heart attack on Monday morning while covering events of the National Games at Raipur stadium. He was rushed to Deen Dayal Upadhyay District Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. (ANI)

38th National Games: Men's, Women's Hockey Title Clashes Decided, Exciting Watersports Action Continues

Haridwar: Madhya Pradesh secured a match with Haryana in the women's hockey final at the 38th National Games 2025 at the Vandana Katariya Hockey Stadium in Haridwar on Wednesday.

MP and Maharashtra played out a 1-1 draw at the end of regular time. Aishwarya Dubey (6') and Nilanjali Rai (43') scored off penalty corners for their respective sides on Wednesday. Madhya Pradesh won the match 4-1 in shootout, as per a press release from 38th National Games.

Meanwhile, Haryana defeated Jharkhand 2-1 in the second semi-final match of the women's event. Kanika Siwach opened the scoring for Haryana in the eighth minute and captain Rani

converted a penalty corner in the 26th minute. Jharkhand captain Albela Rani Toppo found the back of the net in the 42nd minute.

In the men's event, Karnataka defeated Maharashtra 5-4 in the shootout. The regular time ended in a 2-2 draw. Venkatesh Kenche found the back of the net in the 11th minute and Aditya

Saini (12') scored a goal and Prabhjot Singh (32', 49') scored a brace for Punjab.

Moving to Tehri, exciting competitions were witnessed on the second day of the kayaking and canoeing events. Players showcased their talent, particularly in the 500-meter categories. The Services team dominated with a flurry of gold med-

Women's Kayaking (K-2, 500m) category, Uttarakhand's team demonstrated impressive speed, winning the gold medal with a time of 01:56.370 seconds. The Madhya Pradesh team finished in 01:58.037 seconds to take the silver medal, while Odisha secured the bronze with a timing of 01:59.930 seconds.

Whereas, in the Men's Canoeing (C-2, 500m) event, the Services team once again proved their supremacy, completing the race in 01:47.811 seconds to win the gold medal. Odisha's team won silver with a time of 01:50.461 seconds, while Delhi secured the bronze medal with a mere 0.166-second margin, finishing at 01:50.627 seconds.

Furthermore, the Men's Kayaking (K-2, 500m) event also saw Services maintain their dominance, securing the gold medal with a time of 01:36.287 seconds. Uttarakhand's team finished in 01:38.284 seconds to claim silver, while Odisha earned the bronze with a timing of 01:38.897 seconds.

With these enthralling contests in kayaking and canoeing, the competition is set to become even more intense. The final day promises even more exciting encounters for sports enthusiasts. —ANI
